The Departments of Pharmacology and Microbiology at Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences, Anurag University, successfully conducted a one-day **Good Clinical Practice (GCP), Good Clinical Laboratory Practice (GLP) & Ethics Awareness Program** on **30th July 2026** for postgraduate students. The programme was designed to strengthen the students' understanding about Good Clinical Practice guidelines, Good Clinical Laboratory Practice, Laboratory quality systems, Biosafety, Biomedical waste management, and Ethical principles governing Biomedical and Clinical research.

The scientific sessions were delivered by faculty members from the Departments of Pharmacology, Microbiology, Biochemistry and Pathology. The programme covered a wide range of important topics including an overview of ICH-GCP, National Ethical Guidelines, Informed consent, Investigator and sponsor responsibilities, Adverse event reporting, Sample collection and management, Internal quality control, External quality assessment, Laboratory safety, Biomedical waste management, and Ethics awareness. **The “Ethics awareness session”** was delivered by **Dr. Vishnu**, Executive member, Telangana State Medical Council (TGMC). The programme also included pre-test and post-test assessments to evaluate participants' learning outcomes.

A total of **28 postgraduate students** were enrolled for the programme. The programme received excellent feedback from the participants. Postgraduate students appreciated the comprehensive coverage of GCP, GLP, laboratory quality assurance, and research ethics, and expressed that the sessions were highly informative, interactive, and beneficial for their academic and professional development.
